Bigger size in one unit increment	shift & ctrl + >
Smaller size in one unit increment	shift & ctrl + <

Leading [Line Spacing]

Increase leading in one unit increment	shift & alt + >
Reduce leading in one unit increment	shift & alt + <

Tracking/Kerning

Increase kerning in one percent (1%) increment	alt + >
Reduce kerning in one percent (1%) increment	alt + <

Font Weight [Normal, Semi-Bold, Bold etc.]

Increase font weight (where possible)	alt & ctrl + >
Decrease font weight (where possible)	alt & ctrl + <
